New Church Office Administrator

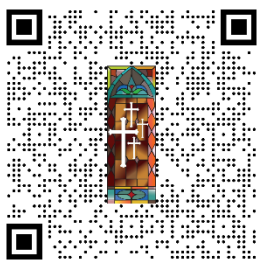
