Health Team Report

At the meeting of the health team on May 23, 2021 the following recommendations were approved and scheduled to begin on June 6, 2021:

1. All in attendance for inside and outside events are welcome to continue to wear masks.
 2. All unvaccinated persons are expected to wear masks for inside and outside events, in accordance with CDC rules.
 3. Fully vaccinated persons are not required to wear a mask.
 4. Everyone is to continue physical distancing. Please continue sitting with your household.
 5. Registration for worship is discontinued. We will revisit if this seems necessary.
 6. All Children's teachers are to be fully vaccinated and children (toddler through youth) are expected to wear masks unless fully vaccinated.
 7. We will not have nursery for infants during Sunday School and Worship Services at this time. We will have Sunday School for Toddlers, children, youth, and adults.
 8. Hand sanitation and cleaning high touch areas are to continue as currently done.
 9. Individuals experiencing COVID symptoms or tested COVID positive are asked to stay home and quarantine.
- Again, everyone is welcome to continue to wear a mask, especially as we get used to gathering again. We realize it will take time to get used to being near each other again, but we are confident it will happen. Thank you so much for your cooperation and patience during this time of caring for one another.
