### All Saints Day Worship November 3rd, 10:30am

Each time we enter into the sanctuary, we pass a memorial plaque posted on the wall. You may not notice it next to the large credenza, or as you are welcomed by the greeters on Sunday morning. It isn't particularly big or flashy. On this plaque, you will see names, and each year we add more, never less. These names are the saints of Northside. Without much fanfare or notice, we are welcomed by those names each Sunday for worship, each time we have a wedding, each funeral, each special event where those big brown doors are swung open wide to all of God's people.

On All Saint's Sunday: **we confess** that those names matter to us and to God; **we declare** that this world is not all there is, and that God has a place for us when we die; **we proclaim** that the love of God and the communion of the Saints do not obey our conceptions of time and space; **we preach** the Good News of Jesus Christ through the testimony of those in our fellowship who find eternal rest in God.
