*On May 13th the CDC released new recommendations for fully vaccinated people. "Fully Vaccinated" means you have received 2 doses of Pfizer or Moderna or one dose of Johnson & Johnson AND are two weeks removed from that second shot. The Health Team is actively looking at how these recommendations affect our church protocols.

We are at "Point D". Larger groups may resume meeting indoors, masked and distanced. After building usage "high touch" areas are to be cleaned. Please schedule your building and grounds usage with the church office. On Sundays we will have worship at 10:30am indoors and online. There will still be no extended session.
