Let Heaven and Nature Sing

This year for Advent our theme echoes with the melodies of the familiar Isaac Watts hymn “Joy to the World! The Lord is Come.” In this tune, heaven and nature, fields and floods, rocks, hills, and plains all shout to praise God. What if we took this as our posture for advent? What if in this season of waiting and preparation we challenged ourselves to offer praise. In the weeks to come, we will hear the mountains, the animals, the wilderness, the earth, and the darkness sing. And each week we will share the Lord’s Supper. So, what will be your song of waiting? Maybe it’s one you hold dear, like “O Come, O Come, Emmanuel,” or maybe it’s a new tune to you like, “View the Present Through the Promise.” This advent, I challenge each of us to sing a song of expectation, to whistle a tune of praise, or to hum a melody of God’s faithfulness from age to age.

In addition to our traditionally celebrated worship services, we are trying something new. We will feature an early Christmas Eve Service at 4:00 pm. This service will be led by our children and youth. It will consist of nativity readings, Christmas carols, and communion. The service will last less than an hour, so it will be accessible to folks who do not drive after dark. If you know of someone who could benefit from such an early service, please invite them to join us in worship. Our 11:00pm service continues to be a centerpiece of worship for our congregation. We will hear the testimony of the scriptures welcoming the incarnation of the Christ-child, share bread and cup at the table, and greet each other with joy as we exit on Christmas morn.

In the season of preparation, I pray that you may find your song. Take time this advent to rest and to pray. May we each devote ourselves to the study of scriptures as we anticipate, once again, the coming of our savior. Joy to the world indeed!

Section 2. Business Meetings

(1) Regular Business Meetings

Regular business meetings shall be held quarterly on the second Sunday night in February, the third Sunday night in May, the second Sunday night in August and the second Sunday night in November. A proposed agenda will be provided prior to the business meeting. A report on membership changes will be included on the agenda.

The deacons recommend that the word “**night**” be deleted from the four stated times for regular business meetings so that the meetings can be held after morning worship when so desired.

Our Financial Outlook

Present: As we stand now, we need to have a monthly contribution level of \$39,000 per month to meet our 2019-2020 budget. We have averaged approximately \$31,000 per month the past four months. This leaves us with a potential shortfall of \$30,000 to \$40,000. My best guess is that we will be \$30,000 in the hole to the budget at the end of March 2020.

Future: We voted to support a budget of \$443,800 for this year. Next year's budget needs to be closer to \$420,000. So, we cannot support an increase and we need to find ways to reduce and/or reallocate our monetary needs for the 2020-2021 budget. Committees need to take this into consideration when formulating their budget requests for next year.
